

Autumn Midweek Competition 2024

- 10 week competition commences Wednesday 1st May 3rd July.
- Games will be played on the indoor courts PLEASE NOTE THE NUMBER OF TEAMS IS LIMITED, FIRST IN, FIRST SERVED

To nominate a team:

 Email AUTUMN team nomination sheet to ona.midweek@gmail.com before 5pm Wednesday 17th of April (this is when nominations close), with all players expecting to play listed, this is needed for team grading. Payment is <u>not</u> required at the time of nominating a team.

INCOMPLETE AND/OR LATE NOMINATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

 All team members are to read and agree to the <u>ONA Midweek competition policy</u> and <u>NNSW Codes of Behaviour Policy</u>. Team contact to sign the nomination form on behalf of the team confirming all players have read and agree to observe the competition policy and code of behaviour.

Team nominations are not guaranteed until the team contact has received an email from the midweek competition secretary.

3. Once nominations close, the midweek secretary will email a link to the team contact. This link will take the team contact to PLAYHQ to register the team for this competition (this is where you will pay your team fee). You will have until Friday 19th of April at 5pm to register and pay your team fee otherwise your spot in the competition will be offered to the next team in line.

To register players to the nominated team:

- 1. Once the team is registered, a link will be automatically sent to the email address the team contact used to register the team. The **team contact** will send the email link to the team's players.
- 2. **Each player** will use the link to register to the team through PlayHQ and pay their Netball NSW fee. If a players NetballNSW registration covers them for the entirety of the competition, they will not need to pay this again.
- 3. Once a player has registered their name will be printed on the scoresheet each week. If you are not on the scoresheet you are not registered and will not be able to take the court.

Fees

- <u>Midweek Team Fees –</u> each team must pay \$460 for the Autumn midweek netball comp.
- Individual Netball NSW player Registration Fee for 12 months Seniors: \$109, Juniors: \$86. (A senior player is anyone 18 years of age or older as of 31/12/2024) The NNSW registration fee is a one-off payment which covers you for the length of time in which you register for. If you have already registered to an ONA or NNSW competition you will not be charged this fee again when registering for another competition providing your registration covers the entirety of the competition.

ALL PLAYERS MUST BE REGISTERED PRIOR TO TAKING THE COURT IF YOU ARE NOT ON THE SCORESHEET, YOU ARE NOT REGISTERED AND CANNOT TAKE THE COURT.

Round 1 Scoresheets will be printed at 10am on Wednesday 1st May, please ensure all players have registered before this time.

FIRST AID The association/committee provide minimal basic first aid such as Band-Aids and ice packs. We recommend teams/players bring their own first aid kit to each game.
